ADDITIONAL DESCRIPTION

Abstract of collection: Collection consists of three folders of publicity stills of Kostelanetz. Original donation also included approximately 30 CDs containing recordings of radio broadcasts.

Biography notes: Andre Kostelanetz (1901-1980) was born in Saint Petersburg, Russia. He was a conductor and arranger, known for arranging and recording classical music for mass audiences. He was married three times and had no children.

Processing information: There are three folders of photos, arranged by year range. The year ranges are: 1920s-1930s, 1930s-1950s, and 1960s-1970s. The CDs in this collection have been cataloged and can be found in our LibraryWorld catalog.

Additional staff notes: The collection arrived in three manila folders, already arranged by date. Photos have been kept in that original arrangement. The CD's have been catalogued and are in LibraryWorld and are housed in a box in the CD Room. Due to the size of this collection, the papers have been housed in the Small Collections Box, starting at Box 1, Folder 8.
