ADDITIONAL DESCRIPTION

Abstract of collection: Collection consists of sheet music, arrangements, and newspaper clippings and programs related to Margaret Whiting. Includes some published copies of Richard Whiting's compositions.

Biography notes: Richard Whiting (1891-1938) was born in Peoria, Illinois to Frank and Blossom Whiting. He was a composer, often collaborating with Johnny Mercer. He was known for songs such as "Hooray for Hollywood." His daughter, Margaret Whiting (1924-2011) was a singer and actress and was one of the first artists signed to Mercer's Capitol Records.

Processing information: The collection is divided into four series: Biographical, Published Sheet Music, Arrangements (piano-vocal parts, unless otherwise noted), and 3D objects.

Additional staff notes: Although sheet music was weeded, all arrangements and biographical documents were kept.
