Abstract of collection: Collection consists of photos, advertisements, and vocal-piano scores of Alice Ghostley.

Biography notes: Alice Margaret Ghostley (1923-2007) was born in Eve, Missouri. A singer and actress, Ghostley appeared in *New Faces of 1952* and television series *Bewitched* and *Designing Women*. She won a Tony Award in 1965 for her work in *The sign in Sidney Brustein's Window*. She was married to Felice Orlandi.

Processing information: Collection is organized into two series: Photographs and Vocal-Piano scores.
